**Degree:** Bachelor of Arts in Psychology

**Purpose of degree:** The Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree is an area of social science study that contributes to students' understanding of behavior and their development of cognitive and analytical skills.

**Degree breakdown:** The Bachelor of Arts in Psychology at the University of North Dakota requires:

- 120 total credits
  - 30 credits must be taken at UND
  - 36 credits must be upper-division (300-level or higher)
- Essential Studies (General Education) Requirements
  - Breadth of Knowledge requirements waived
  - Special Emphasis requirements still needed
- Curriculum approved by the College of Arts and Sciences
- 2.2 GPA in Psychology coursework and 2.0 cumulative GPA for graduation
